SILT (n., silt) earthy matter, fine sand, or the like carried by moving or running water and deposited as a sediment.

When the river banks swell, when the river banks burst, when the river banks weep a wide wet song, it leaves behind silt, thick on the ground, a wrap of fabric fertile with sound, clinging to moisten soil, kissing to awaken the earth.

From this grows the beauty of an individual statement.
