Stormie Mills's artwork is hanging in galleries around the world. Now you can also have a piece hanging in your wardrobe.

Former street artist Mills and Chrissie Catling, owner and designer of S2 clothing, have combined their talents to create a limited-edition little black dress, which will be sold for charity.

"S2 is a more minimalist look so we've used a shift dress from our spring summer collection," Catling says.

"We've been to Stormie's art exhibitions, so we thought we'd ask him if he could help. He's been extremely generous."

Only 40 of the dresses – which Stormie has screen-printed by hand – have been made. Ten will sell with matching limited-edition framed Mills prints.

The dress and print sets will sell for \$1000 each and the dresses for \$499, with profits going to the WA AIDS Council.
